ABOUT US


Red Cross of Krusevac is a humanitarian, non-governmental organisation that provides humanitarian aid, disaster relief and non-formal education in City of Krusevac (Serbia). Local volunteers and activists founded it on 6 October 1876. Today, the organization has 1286 members, more than 500 volunteers, as well as 4 full time working professionals. Red Cross of Krusevac is mainly intended for the youth.

In the Red Cross of Krusevac, youth can also attend various programs of non-formal education, learn about Erasmus Plus programs, international participation and European values. One of our main goals is to guarantee creative and quality time for youth to spend, by projects in the following themes: non-formal education and training, creative workshops, international youth projects, voluntary work, etc.

KRUŠEVAC

The city of Kruševac is one of the most historically significant cities of Serbia, located in the central part of the country, in the fertile valley of the river Rasina, surrounded by the gentle hills of the Jastrebac, Kopaonik and Goč mountains.

Founded in the 14th century by Prince Lazar, Kruševac was once the capital of medieval Serbia and the heart of its cultural and political life. Today, it remains a city of great historical importance and vibrant tradition, with numerous cultural monuments such as the Lazarica Church, the Medieval Fortress, and the National Museum. Kruševac is also a dynamic modern city with a strong educational and industrial base and a proud tradition of volunteerism and community spirit.

With a population eager to celebrate art, music, theatre, and sports, Kruševac regularly hosts festivals and public events that reflect the spirit of its people. Its cafes and restaurants serve delicious Serbian cuisine, and the city offers easy access to nearby nature parks, hiking trails, and winter sports at Kopaonik.



Key Local Highlights

- **Lazarica Church (14th century):**

A masterpiece of Morava school architecture built by Prince Lazar, located in the city center.

- **Kruševac Fortress (Tvrđava):**

The remains of the medieval capital of Serbia with scenic views and historical importance.

- **National Museum Kruševac:**

Offers insights into the city's rich history, including archaeological and ethnological collections.

- **Monument to Kosovo Heroes:**

Located at the central square, it's a key symbol of Serbian medieval history and the Battle of Kosovo (1389).



What to Bring

- Comfortable and warm clothing (average September temperature: 20°C - 25°C).
- Reusable water bottles and eco-friendly items to align with Erasmus+ sustainability goals.
- Your own personal insurance.
