A detailed agenda will be shared prior to the meeting.



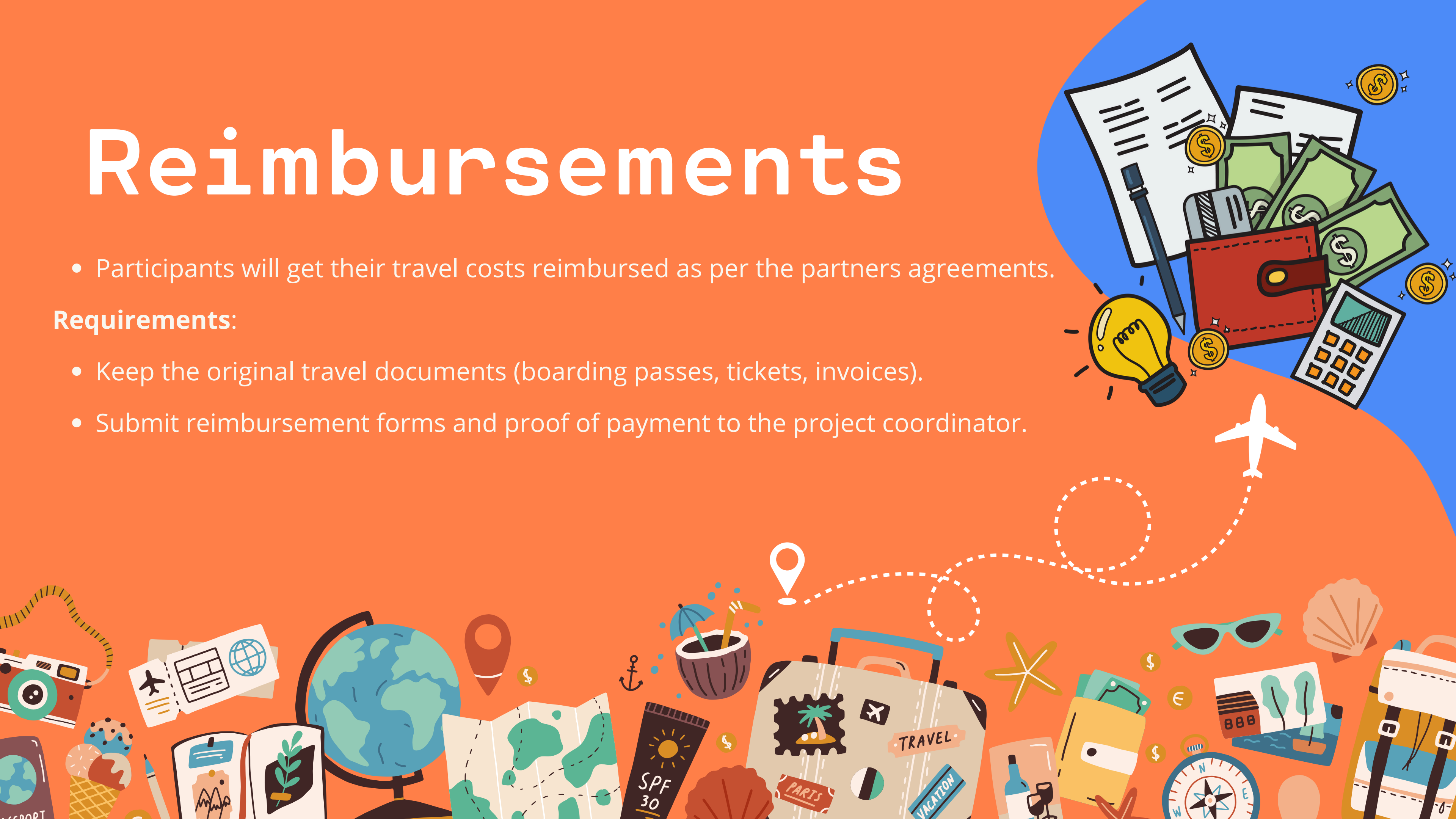
Meals and Costs

- **Additional Expenses:** Any personal expenses outside the official program will not be reimbursed.



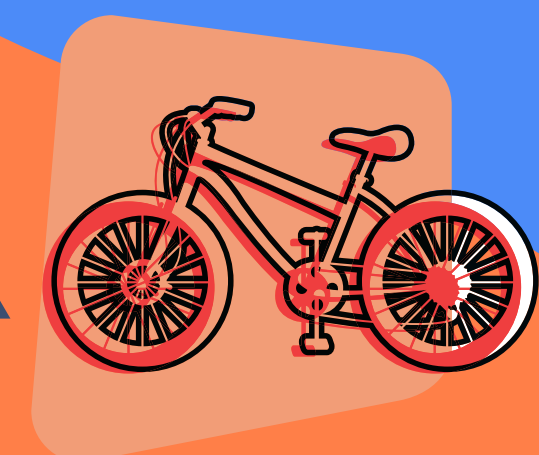
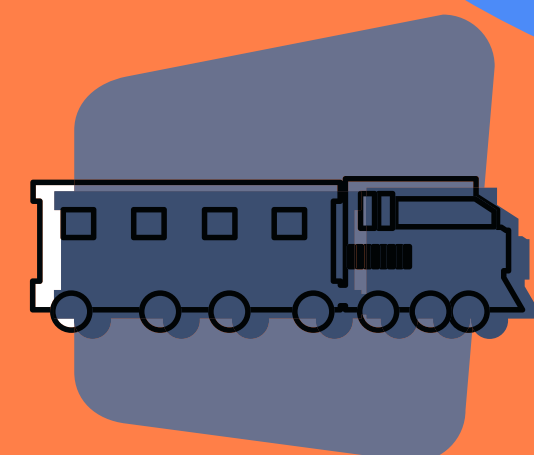
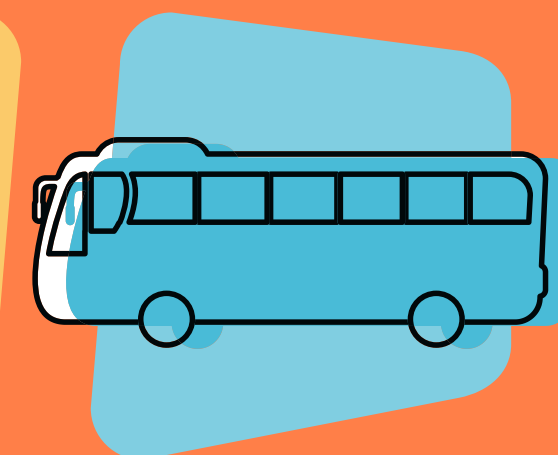

- **Virus Precautions:** Masks, hand sanitizer, and social distancing will be observed if applicable.

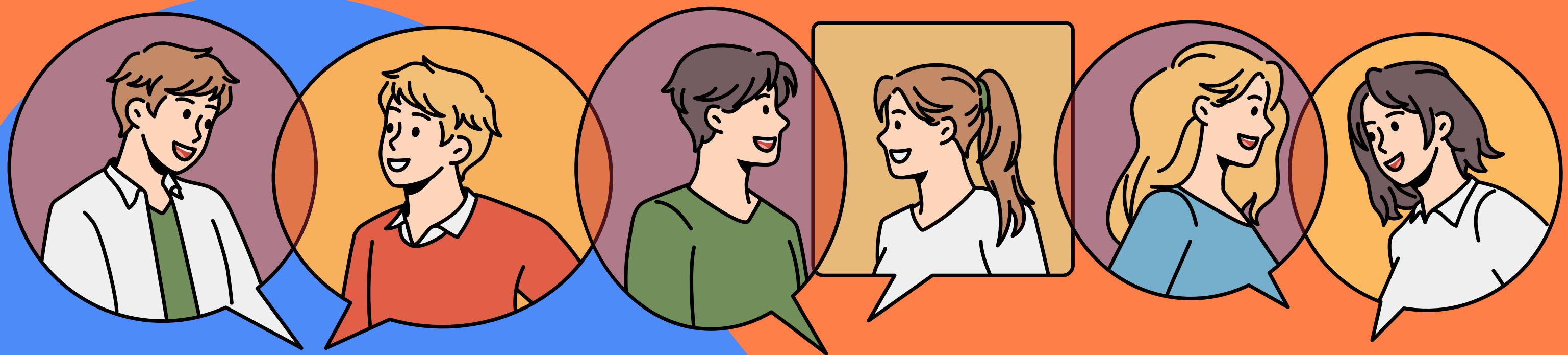
